1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing

2. Race Format

The event comprises of 3 races

3. Fees

Entry fee : £10 per boat

4. Schedule

Registration: from 09:30

Briefing: 10:30 approx

Race 1 : 11:00 start

Race 2 : 13:00 start (approx.)

Race 3 : 14:15 start (approx.)

4. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and will be displayed at the club

5. Courses

The courses to be sailed will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. Scoring

1 race is required to constitute a series

The event comprises 3 races with 2 to count. In the event of a tie ISAF Appendix A 8.2 (who had the best recent score) shall apply Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entries, but at least for the first 3 places.

7. Insurance

Each participating boat will be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least £3,000,000.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and the crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions or any inspection of the boat limits reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and her management.

The race organisers, who are the Glossop Sailing Club, and Race Committee shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/person in charge or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races.

9. Cancellation

If cancellation is required due to weather or any other unforeseen event, then this will be notified via the website at least 24 hours before the start time for the event.
